For the sixth year in row, the region's overall traffic set an all-time record as the airports served 132.7 million passengers, eclipsing the 129.7 million passenger mark set in 2016. The international sector set the pace in 2017 as it handled 47.5 million international passengers, breaking the all-time international passenger traffic record set in 2016, while growing at a 3.5 percent clip. Our 85.1 million domestic passengers. The domestic sector, which makes up 63 percent of the region's passengers, saw slightly less robust growth than international, but nevertheless eclipsed the previous record also set in 2016 while handling 85.1 million passengers (a net addition of 1.3 million passengers, for a 1.6 percent gain). The region's total cargo volume grew a strong 7.5 percent, the fastest growth since the 17 percent gain during the economic recovery in 2010. Growth was broad-based as both the domestic and international sectors registered solid gains of 6.1 and 8.3 percent respectively.
