













### Middle class expected to grow from 410m people today, to 560m by 2038

Latin America & the Caribbean Middle Class\*\* expected to represent 74% of the population by 2038







O&D traffic has grown by 6.2% per year since 2002


O&D passengers per year, from/to/within Latin America & the Caribbean (millions)







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






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

### Demand for some 2,700 new aircraft in Latin America & the Caribbean




